

**Cupping of Bourbon Pointu
by professionals de l'arbre à café (Paris)**

Mr. Frederic DESCROIX,

I return to you after tasting the samples you sent me.

In light and fresh roast, I've found good quality but a large discretion. I say me, they do not agree to the espresso.

Then I've tried a second time, three weeks after roasting, is there, they are fully revealed.

I've found very fine and delicate, cafes listening.

Fragrance/Aroma : fruit and red flowers.

A very Sweetness and air cup, attack on these **red berries and flavors greedy (buns, cakes, yeast) and almond milk, hazelnut, and finish black squid ink, quartz, humus**, leaving a small pleasant bitterness.

The **Grand Cru** became **a great delicacy**, and **Aftertaste very large length, mouth summoned rhubarb, woody flavors, the pink, spices**. It was perhaps more discreet than the Sublime.
